FSC CERTIFIED PAPERS

Ensures that papers meet the Forest Stewardship Council's (FSC) standards for responsible forest management and responsible use of forest resources.

100% POST CONSUMER & PROCESSED CHLORINE FREE

Post consumer fiber is made from waste paper that has served its intended purpose and has been separated from solid waste to be recycled into new paper. Processed Chlorine Free (PCF) refers to post consumer recycled papers processed using no chlorine or chlorine derivatives.



GREEN-E CERTIFIED

Green-e is the nation's leading independent certification and verification program for renewable energy and greenhouse gas emission reductions in the retail market. The Green-e logo identifies products made with certified renewable energy, including but not limited to, wind power, solar power, low impact hydropower, and biomass.

ALTERNATIVE FIBER

Alternative fibers are no-tree substitutes for papermaking and include sources such as bamboo and sugar cane bagasse, which requires fewer chemicals and less energy for processing than virgin tree fiber.



CARBON NEUTRAL

As a member of the Chicago Climate Exchange, Neenah paper has achieved Carbon Neutrality through net reductions in greenhouse gas emissions. These methods include but are not limited to the use of Green-e certified renewable energy and other renewable energy sources and the implementation of energy saving upgrades.



GREEN SEAL

Signifies that all of our recycled papers are made with a minimum of 30% post consumer fiber and that mill processes, including packaging, are environmentally preferable.
